General schedule: 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday. Occasional evenings and weekends. This will likely start at 3 clinical days a week but flexible up to five clinical days.

### **Summary**

### **Role and Responsibilities:**

\* Their role includes developing appropriate treatment plan and providing effective management of patient care with proper evaluation. The clinician must practice in accordance with all applicable state and federal laws, including current DEA regulations. In addition, the clinician must practice within currently accepted guidelines and scope of practice documents such as those provided by reputable professional associations in the field, to include but not limited to American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, World Professional Association of Transgender Health, American Academy of Psychiatry, American Psychiatric Nurses Association.

### **\*Preferred Skills & Experience**

The qualified applicant will have at minimum a Master's Degree in Nursing Science from an accredited Nurse Practitioner Program specifically focused in Psychiatric Mental Health Nursing. In addition, the applicant must possess a current license in good standing with the state of Alaska, as well as hold a current certification as a PMHNP. The qualified applicant will have training

and certification that allow them to work with clients who have experienced complex trauma, as well as clients who identify as a sexual or gender minority. If such training/certification is not current, the applicant must be willing to pursue that training regularly while employed at the clinic.
